The purpose of this letter is to formally notify you that the Basic Life Support for Professionals training materials that you submitted for review, along with the supplemental information, is acceptable for Emergency Medical Technician I (Basic) certification by the Sacramento County Emergency Medical Services Agency (SCEMS).

SCEMS requires a current CPR card for EMT-I certification. The CPR card must be, by policy, an American Heart Association, Healthcare provider designation or equivalent. After reviewing the Basic Life Support for Professionals and the supplemental training materials, it was determined to be equivalent to the American Heart Association's CPR for the Healthcare Provider.
